

PASTORAL MESSAGE

SABBATH SCHOOL AND PERSONAL MINISTRIES— DEPARTMENTAL POLICIES

Philosophy

The Sabbath School and Personal Ministries Department of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists was established as a major setting for religious education in the Church. It exists to teach and proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ in response to the command of Jesus, in the context of the three angels' messages of **Revelation 14: 6 - 12.** To honour this original purpose, the Sabbath School and Personal Ministries Department continues to communicate the good news with the objective to win, hold, and train for Jesus Christ, children, youth and adults in all the world.

The Sabbath School and Personal Ministries Department endeavours to motivate all members to dynamic Christian service with the conviction that "The church of Christ is organised for service" (MH 148), and "Every son and daughter of God is called to be a missionary; we are called to the service of God and our fellow men" (MH 395).

Recognising that "the Sabbath school work is important, and all who are interested in the truth should endeavour to make it prosperous" (CSW 9); that "the Sabbath school, if rightly conducted, is one of God's great instrumentalities to bring souls to a knowledge of the truth" (CSW 115); and that "Every church should be a training school for Christian workers. Its members should be taught how to give Bible readings, how to conduct and teach Sabbath school classes, how best to help the poor and to care for the sick, how to work for the unconverted . . . There should not only be teaching, but actual work under experienced instructors" (ChS 59); the Sabbath School and Personal Ministries Department functions as the primary religious educational and training system at the local church level of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, whereby the majority of Seventhday Adventists world-wide learn the teachings of the Bible, including the tenets of the Church, and become motivated and equipped to share the gospel with everyone.

Desired Outcomes

Produce resources and programmes that are Christcentred, Bible-based, and user-orientated for the unions/attached fields. These involve a variety of modalities in emerging technologies and media that effectively engage audiences. They are presented through extensive and varied training media resulting in the following: 1. Bible Study — Regular individual and group study of God's Word, prayer, and other devotional practices.

2. Fellowship — Christ-centred relationships throughout every aspect of the weekly Sabbath School programme and an atmosphere of love and acceptance in church life.

3. Community Outreach—Discovery of spiritual gifts that educate, equip, motivate, and mobilise members in all forms of personal evangelism, and organised local churches to be transforming agents in their community.

4. World Mission—Expression and perpetuation of a clear vision of the Church's mission to the world.

In the Seventh-day Adventist Church, Sabbath School and Personal Ministries are closely related departments, both focused on discipleship and spiritual growth, where Sabbath School primarily provides structured Bible Study and education, while Personal Ministries focuses on actively reaching out to the community and engaging in evangelism, with both working together to nurture new members and equip existing ones for ministry within the church.

Key points about their relationship:

Shared Goal

Both departments aim to develop mature Christians and actively involve them in the church's mission of sharing the gospel.

Complementary Functions

Sabbath School provides the foundational knowledge through Bible study, while Personal Ministries puts that knowledge into practice through outreach and evangelism. • Organizational Structure

At the church level, they operate as separate entities but often collaborate on initiatives and programs.

Leadership Coordination

The leaders of both departments often work together to strategize and coordinate ministry efforts.

Member Involvement

Ideally, members participate in both Sabbath School classes and Personal Ministries activities to fully engage in their spiritual development and outreach.


- 1. **WELCOME:** We warmly welcome you all to the Lord's house.



Pastor's Appreciation Sabbath, February 1, 2025

Scripture Reading

1 Corinthians 15: 1 – 10, KJV.

1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;

2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.

3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;

4 And that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

5 And that He was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve:

6 After that, He was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.

9 For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

Receive. Impart.

"Christ has bidden us, through the prophet, "Deal thy bread to the hungry," and "satisfy the afflicted soul;" "when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him," and "bring the poor that are cast out to thy house." Isa. 58:7-10. He has bidden us, "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature." Mark 16:15. But how often our hearts sink, and faith fails us, as we see how great is the need, and how small the means in our hands. Like Andrew looking upon the five barley loaves and the two little fishes, we exclaim, "What are they among so many?" Often we hesitate, unwilling to give all that we have, fearing to spend and to be spent for others. But Jesus has bidden us, "Give ye them to eat." His command is a promise; and behind it is the same power that fed the multitude beside the sea.

In Christ's act of supplying the temporal necessities of a hungry multitude is wrapped up a deep spiritual lesson for all His workers. Christ received from the Father; He imparted to the disciples; they imparted to the multitude; and the people to one another. So all who are united to Christ will receive from Him the bread of life, the heavenly food, and impart it to others.

In full reliance upon God, Jesus took the small store of loaves; and although there was but a small portion for His own family of disciples, He did not invite them to eat, but began to distribute to them, bidding them serve the people. The food multiplied in His hands; and the hands of the disciples, reaching out to Christ Himself the Bread of Life, were never empty. The little store was sufficient for all. After the wants of the people had been supplied, the fragments were gathered up, and Christ and His disciples ate together of the precious, Heaven-supplied food.

The disciples were the channel of communication between Christ and the people. This should be a great encouragement to His disciples today. Christ is the great center, the source of all strength. His disciples are to receive their supplies from Him. The most intelligent, the most spiritually minded, can bestow only as they receive. Of themselves they can supply nothing for the needs of the soul. We can impart only that which we receive from Christ; and we can receive only as we impart to others. As we continue imparting, we continue to receive; and the more we impart, the more we shall receive. Thus we may be constantly believing, trusting, receiving, and imparting.

The work of building up the kingdom of Christ will go forward, though to all appearance it moves slowly and impossibilities seem to testify against advance. The work is of God, and He will furnish means, and will send helpers, true, earnest disciples, whose hands also will be filled with food for the starving multitude. God is not unmindful of those who labor in love to give the word of life to perishing souls, who in their turn reach forth their hands for food for other hungry souls."


